## Absent Children.

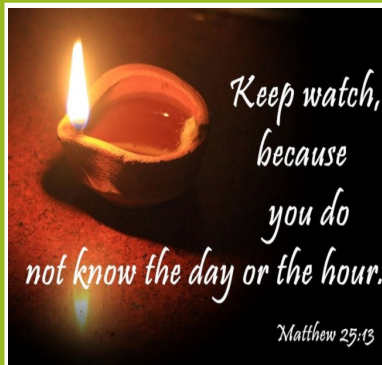
