THIS WEEK'S HEART OF GOLD AWARD WINNERS ARE...

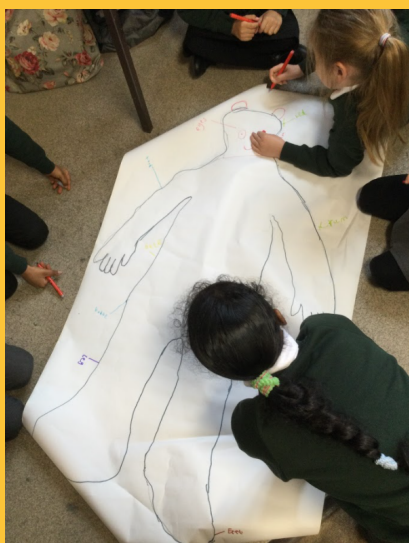
