Developing your behaviour toolkit

Developing your behaviour toolkit is a one-day workshop aimed at building your understanding of behaviour. We will think about how behaviour will change as a child grows and develops, and how we can use this understanding to develop strategies to promote positive behaviour.

This workshop is for the parents and carers of young people with a special educational need or disability. It may not be suitable where you have been given a different understanding of the behaviour presented by your child, such as difficulties with attachment. The content of this workshop is designed to cover a wide range of diagnoses including autism spectrum conditions, ADHD and learning disability. However, a specific diagnosis is not required.

You must book a place in order to attend.
