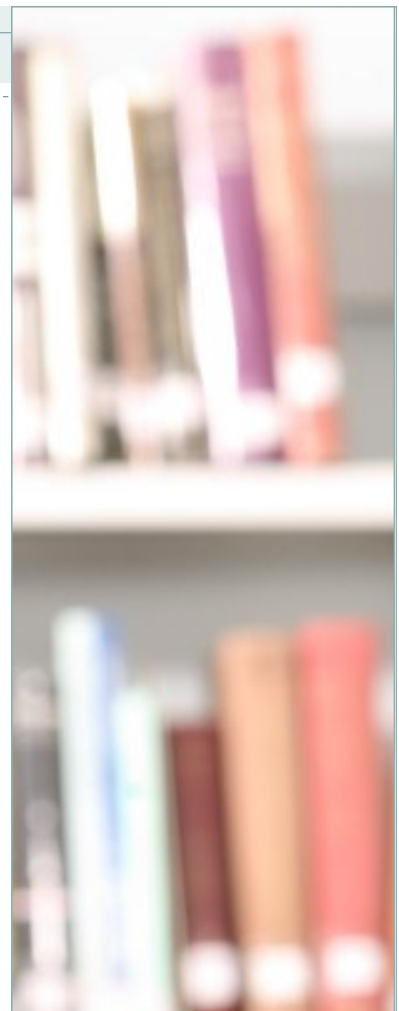

Easy Guide: How to Apply



1. Come and take a look when you're in Year 4 or Year 5

Open days are in July or ring us up:
01752 208787

2. There is a free admissions test you can try when you're in Year 5

Register at the school in April
Come to try the test in June



3. You can do some practice tests at home if you like

Free past papers are on the school website
<http://www.dhsb.org/11-familiarisation/>
Any adult can help you with exam technique and timings

4. Do the real admissions test

Register on the school website between April and August
<http://www.dhsb.org/admissions>
Come to do the test in September when you start Year 6

5. In October you will find out if you passed the admissions test

6. Then you can apply for three secondary schools when you are in Year 6

-- Put DHSB as your preferred choice if you passed the admissions test

7. And finally...In March you will know which school you got - perhaps it will be DHSB!
