WW1 CENTENARY ART COMMISSIONS - POPPIES WAVE PLYMOUTH

Class 5 recently took part in a digital film-making workshop, aimed at documenting the 14-18-Now 'Poppies Wave' installation on Plymouth Hoe. The artwork, which features thousands of ceramic poppies surrounding the Naval War Memorial, is currently touring the UK, marking the centenary of the First World War.

The children learned to plan a news report, and then, using industry-standard equipment, filmed their reports from Plymouth Hoe. We hope to be able to share these videos with parents very shortly. Photographs from the day can be viewed on the School Website.

Foundation and Year 1 Healthy Smiles Healthy Smiles is an oral health programme designed and delivered by NHS Plymouth. It involves painting fluoride varnish onto the teeth of young children to give them the best possible protection against tooth decay. The programme is free. If you would like your child to take part in this programme, simply complete the medical form and hand it back into school by Wednesday 11th October. The school office does have spare forms, should you require one. *Please note this programme is not a substitute for regular dental care.*

The photographer will be in school on Tuesday 14th November. You may bring in younger and older siblings (not in school) from 8:30am to be photographed as a family group. Siblings in school will be photographed together during the morning in school and each child will also be photographed individually. Your child will bring home the proof of their photograph; please read the instructions on how to order.
