

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## Operation Encompass

Supporting children through key adults

Operation Encompass has been launched across the city and is live with immediate effect.

Domestic abuse happens in our schools every day and there are no current procedures for the early reporting of Domestic Abuse incidents to schools and this means that our children, the often inaudible and invisible victims of Domestic Abuse, are left without the support and nurture that they need when they need it most.

Operation Encompass is the solution which is a police led, school based early intervention safeguarding scheme which supports children who are exposed to Domestic Abuse. It was created to ensure that by 9am on the next day the school will be informed that a child has been involved in a Domestic Abuse incident. This knowledge, given to the school's trained Key Adult allows the provision of immediate early intervention through overt or silent support, dependent upon the needs and wishes of the child.

The named Encompass key adults in our school are Mrs Brady and Mr Cotter.
